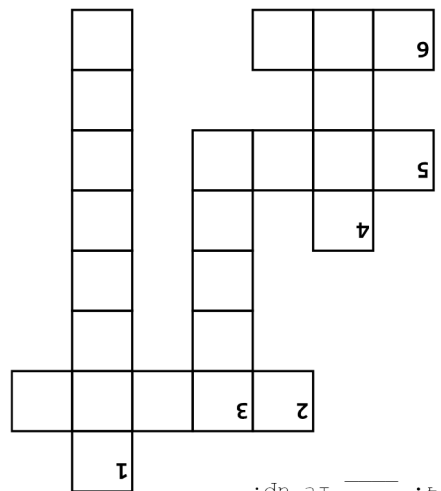

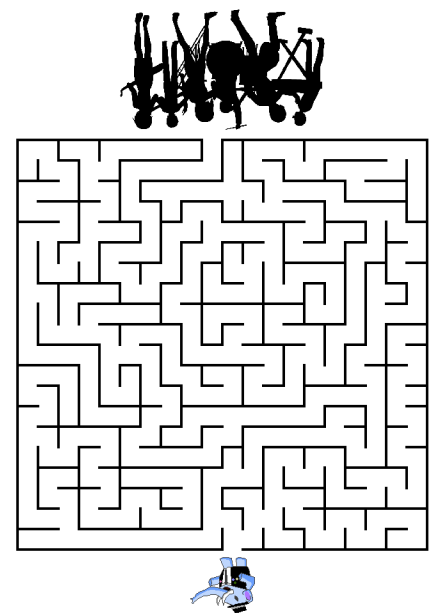

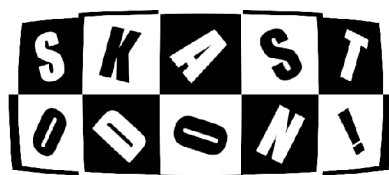

What is Skastodon?

Skastodon is an inclusive space for the ska community, including musicians, artists, fans and more. It is also a place for all well-meaning sentient beings, who just want a fun place to socialize. We welcome everyone from the ska, punk, reggae, rocksteady, new wave, or other related music fandoms. We are also proud proponents of the Ska Goth Alliance.

Mastodon? What's that?!

Mastodon like that place with the bird, except instead of just one website, it's several that all talk to each other. Anyone can start a Mastodon server, and servers can all interact. So you can connect with friends all over the internet. Also there's no algorithm. You just see the newest posts first.

Who owns Skastodon?

Skastodon is owned and operated by Brian Transplant, a musician and creator from the Metro Detroit area. The site is a labor of love. Brian does not want to harvest your data. That's really hard to do on Mastodon, and even if he could, he wouldn't. The site is self-funded and powered by the occasional donation. It has no corporate ties.

How can I join?

Just point your web browser at skastodon.com and sign up for an account.

You can also use one of several Mastodon apps.
